**Twinsburg Township Named “Tree City USA”**  
*Township to Host Arbor Day Celebration on Friday, April 30, 2010*

**Twinsburg Township, Summit County, Ohio – April 19, 2010** – Last month Alan Siewert, Regional Urban Forester with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, Division of Forestry presented Twinsburg Township with the prestigious “Tree City USA” designation. This honor recognizes continuing Township efforts to plant and maintain trees on Township properties. It is notable that Twinsburg Township is only the second Township ever in the entire State of Ohio (and the first ever in northeast Ohio) to receive this award.

In conjunction with receiving its “Tree City USA” designation, the Board of Trustees will host an Arbor Day Celebration on Friday, April 30, 2010 @ 12:00 noon @ Robertson Park (intersection of Twinsburg Road, Katz Road, Lynne Drive, and Timber Avenue). The public is invited to attend, with parking on Katz Road west of Lynne Drive. This event will include the planting of a Shingle Oak tree, donated to the Township by Davey Tree Farm. Attendees will also be able to take a “tree tour” of Robertson Park, led by Township forester Jason Knowles.
