**Township Christmas TREEcycling Program Now Underway**  
*Free Service for Occupied Residential Properties*

**Twinsburg Township, Summit County, Ohio – January 10, 2012** – The Board of Twinsburg Township Trustees is pleased to announce that the Township’s first-ever Christmas TREEcycling Program is now underway for the 2011-2012 winter season. Collection by the Township Service Department will begin this week and end next week, weather permitting.

The Township currently offers Christmas tree collection services free of charge to Township residential properties. A property must, however, have a house on it in order to receive this service. The Service Department collects Christmas trees during a one-week period, generally beginning during the second week of January. For the 2011-2012 winter season, collection will begin on *Thursday January 12* and end on *Tuesday January 17*, weather permitting.

No application is necessary to receive this service, but residents are asked to follow a few simple guidelines to help keep this service cost-effective and efficient for all.
