Multi-Road Construction Advisory

Work Underway on Darrow Road (SR 91), County Roads, Township Roads, and Anthony Lane

Twinsburg Township, Summit County, Ohio – October 18, 2010 – Road construction will occur throughout the Township in the next few weeks, so drivers are urged to exercise caution, be patient, and watch out for construction workers on Township roadways.

First, the Ohio Department of Transportation will resurface northbound lanes of Darrow Road (SR 91) in the Township, extending north from the Hudson corporation line (@ Fairway Boulevard/Marcelita's) to the Twinsburg corporation line (@ Old Mill Road/Circle K). The roadway will remain open during the project, with northbound traffic routed away from the edge lane in the project area. The project is anticipated to last approximately two weeks.

Second, the Summit County Engineer is nearing completion of the 2010 County Road Program, as well as seasonal ditch mowing, along County-maintained roads in the Township, including all or portions of Chamberlin, Highland, Liberty, Old Mill, Ravenna, Stow, and Twinsburg Roads. County and contractor crews are making their way through the Township on these roads to complete asphalt rejuvenation, crack sealing, spot paving, resurfacing, and striping projects.

Third, Twinsburg Township, with assistance from the Summit County Engineer, is nearing completion of the 2010 Township Road Program, as well as seasonal ditch mowing, along

Township roads. A complete list of affected roads is available at Township Hall. The cost of this work is estimated at \$92,400.00 and will be paid for from the Township's General Fund. Contractor crews have been making their way throughout the Township on affected roads to complete asphalt rejuvenation, crack sealing, spot paving, resurfacing, and striping projects.

Fourth, Twinsburg Township will commence work this week on the Anthony Lane Improvement Project, a resurfacing project along the entire length of Anthony Lane in the Township and the City of Twinsburg, from the roadway's west end at Cannon Road in the City to the its east dead end in the Township. Half of the project's \$85,236.00 cost will be paid for with an Ohio Public Works Commission secured by the Township, with the remainder (local share) being paid entirely by the Township from the Township's General Fund. The Township's contractor is Perrin Asphalt Company, and the County Engineer will provide construction administration and inspection services on the project. The project is anticipated to last approximately two weeks.
