Twinsburg Township, Summit County, Ohio – February 28, 2019 – The Board of Twinsburg Township Trustees is pleased to announce that a Special Branch Chipping round is scheduled for Monday, March 11, 2019. Due to the recent high winds that struck the area, many residents are busy cleaning up their yards and placing branches curbside. This will be a one-time special service, beginning on Monday, March 11<sup>th</sup>, and continuing until the entire Township is cleared. Service Department crews will collect from each Township street only once, and residents are encouraged to have branches out prior to the Monday 7:30 AM pick-up. All branches are to be neatly stacked piles, no greater than ten-inch diameter, and keep all branches out of any roadside ditches. Please do not mix branches with leaves.

The 2019 regular branch chipping schedule will begin Monday, May 13, 2019 and continue on June 10<sup>th</sup>; July 8<sup>th</sup>; August 12<sup>th</sup>; and finally September 9, 2019. No application is necessary to receive this service, but residents are asked to follow a few simple guidelines to help keep this service cost-effective and efficient for all.
